This document is a tool to assist students in planning and structuring their degree according to course requirements, and can be used in conjunction with the **Tele's Angels Area of Study Unit Lists**. These resources are not official Academic Advice and should be used in combination with the **Macquarie University Handbook** (www.handbook.mq.edu.au/2014/). We recommend that you also speak to a **Department of Ancient History Academic Advisors** (email ancienthistory@mq.edu.au for more information).

This resource is targeted at those undertaking a Bachelor of Arts, but can also be applied to a Bachelor of Ancient History.

How to use this resource:

Step 1 [see page 2]

Set up your **degree framework** (100-, 200-, and 300-level).

Step 2 [see page 3]

Check the **degree requirements** in the **Handbook**. Insert the general 100-, 200- and 300-level requirements and total credit points required into your degree framework, and estimate how many units that would equal (most units are 3 credit points, therefore "minimum 18 credit points at 300-level" would be 6 units).

Step 3 [see page 4]

Look up the **requirements for your major** (i.e. 'Ancient History - Greece, Rome and Late Antiquity' or 'Ancient History – Egypt and the Near East') and insert the major-specific 100-, 200- and 300-level requirements (including required units) into your degree framework.

Step 4 [see page 5]

Now you have the general and specific details laid out, look at the **Handbook** for **units**. Select units which interest you from what is required (always check if these units have prerequisites, as you may need to also include prerequisite units in your plan). When it is filled in, **add up your total number of credit points**. You will notice that it may not equal the total amount required to complete your degree, so the remaining units can be taken from departments outside of your major.

Step 5 [see page 6]

You can then explore the possibility of undertaking **complementary (elective) units** in other departments and faculties. Always check whether or not you meet the **prerequisites** for units. Don't forget your **People and Planet** units! If you need ideas, check out our **Area of Study Unit Lists**.
